

ANCIENT EGYPT TIMELINE

INSTRUCTIONS

- You are going to construct a timeline of the major events in the ancient Egyptian civilization.
- You will be constructing the timeline to scale on the provided ruler line. Please follow instructions on the template, and calculate the number of years represented by each inch on the timeline.
- Record that scale in the "Key" box.
- Using a ruler, mark every inch on the timeline in black ink and label it with the appropriate year, also in black ink.
- Cut out each event box and glue it to the timeline at the correct location along the line. Make sure that the event is glued directly above or below the date location, so that it can be connected to the timeline with a straight ruler line.
- Draw a straight, black line, using a ruler, from each event box to the correct location on the timeline.
- Cut out the title of the timeline and paste it on your finished timeline.
