


## ITALIAN PENINSULA MAP

Use pages 263 and 269 of *Journey Across Time* to help you complete your map of the Italian Peninsula and surrounding areas. All locations should be accurately labeled, free of spelling and capitalization errors, and in thin, black sharpie.

1. Label the Mediterranean Sea, Adriatic Sea, Tyrrhenian Sea, Ionian Sea, and Atlantic Ocean.
2. Label the islands of Sicily, Corsica, and Sardinia.
3. Draw and label the Po River, Tiber River, and Danube River. Color them blue.
4. Draw and label the Alps, Pyrenees, and Apennines, using  as your symbol.
5. Locate and label the cities of Rome, Carthage, and New Carthage. Use a black circle to mark the absolute location of each city.
6. Label the areas of Spain, Africa, and Italy.
7. All areas that were settled by the Carthaginians should be colored orange.
8. All areas that were settled by the Etruscans should be colored yellow.
9. All areas that were settled by the Greeks should be colored green.
10. All areas that were settled by the Latins should be colored purple.
11. In the upper, left-hand corner, complete a key, titled: Italy, 500 B.C.
12. Draw a compass rose with the eight cardinal and intermediate directions.
13. Color all remaining land brown and color all water blue.
14. Title your map 'Italian Peninsula' at the top.
